



Virtual Visits through Apple FaceTime


Check that FaceTime is enabled on your Apple Device





- Make sure to provide our staff with an email address / phone number that is reachable through FaceTime (*email address/phone # has check mark next to it*).



- Expect a FaceTime call from our staff. The caller ID on the incoming call will be mrdipad00#@gmail.com (the # will be a number between 0 – 8).
- Please accept the call to begin speaking with one of our providers.



Features to know...

- **Effects Button:** Applies filters / camera effects to the FaceTime call. This feature will not be used during the call.
- **Mute Button:** This will mute all audio from your end and the provider will not be able to hear you (Mute is enabled if the button is colored white).
- **Flip Button:** Pressing this button will switch the Facetime camera from the front facing camera to the rear facing camera (or vice versa). This feature will be useful as you (or a helper) will be pointing the camera at various body areas throughout the skin exam.
- **End Button:** Pressing this button will terminate the FaceTime call. Press this once you are finished with the call.

- Once the virtual visit is over, Tap the “End” button to end the FaceTime call.
